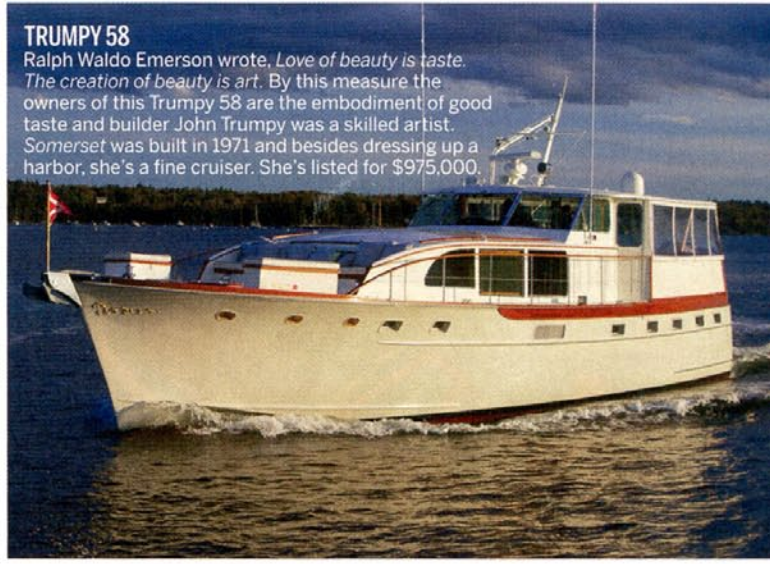
REGULATOR 26

Traditional shapes strike a chord with many of us—one that reverberates long after trends have come and gone. The Regulator 26 still plays that tune.



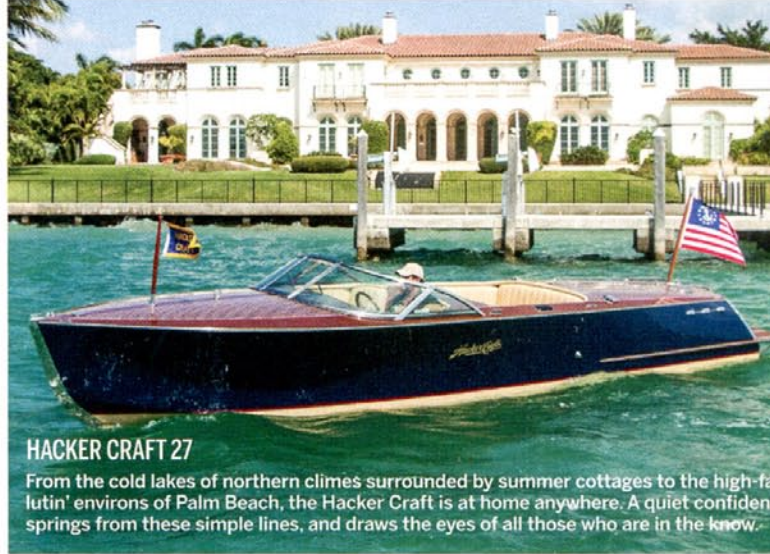
TRUMPY 58

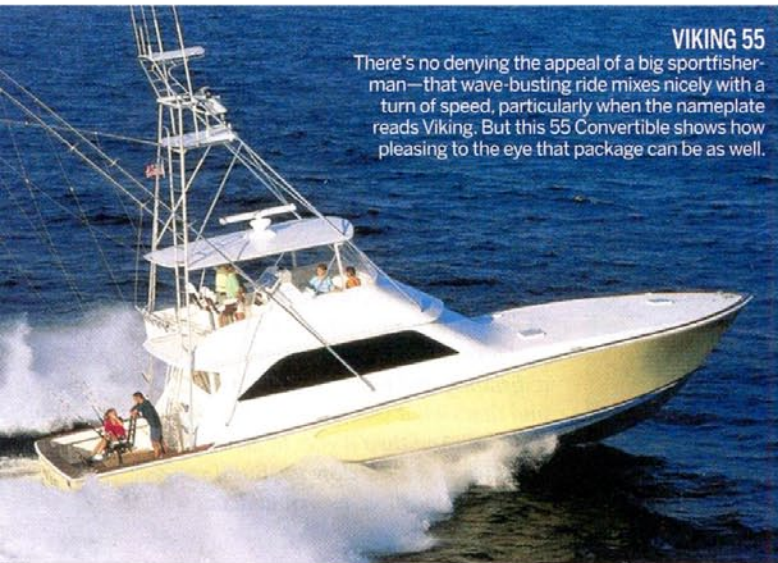
HINKLEY 36 PICNIC BOAT

Even people who don't know anything about boats know about the Picnic Boat. It reached across the culture to remind folks of a Golden Age when things were simpler and more beautiful.



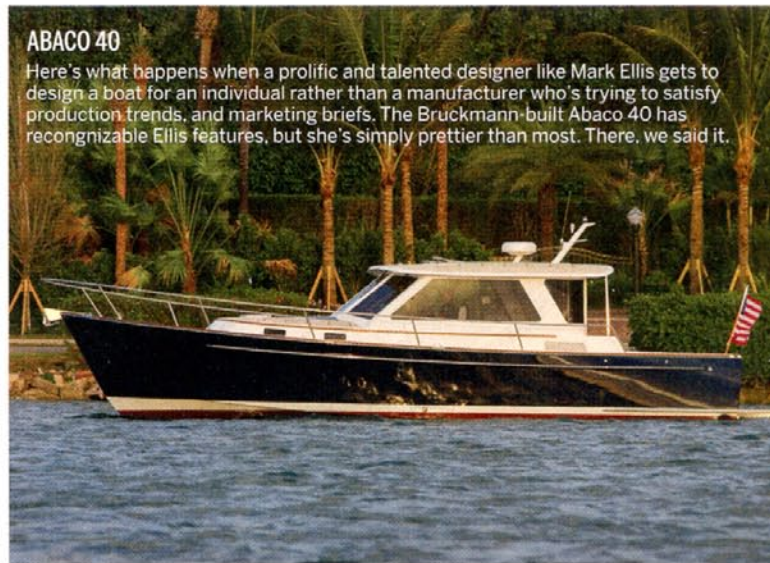
HACKER CRAFT 27
